

LAW SCHOOLS HELPED AND HURT BY THE US NEWS FORMULA

These are the schools whose overall rankings are most improved by the inclusion of the US News and World Report data omitted from the Hylton Rankings. Since the US News provided numerical rankings for only the top 100 schools, only those schools' rankings can be compared to their corresponding position in the Hylton Rankings. (Note the Hylton Rankings are compiled using only the US News "Peer Assessment" and "Median LSAT" data.)
